Boulevard CID busy undertaking economic development, marketing and corridor beautification

SOUTH FULTON-The Fulton Industrial Boulevard corridor is continuing to make quality of life improvements along the corridor. The Boulevard CID announced that a few troubled businesses have received notices of citations, a cemetery is being cleaned up and a piece of public art is being restored.

"The cleanup of this cemetery is appropriate as it hasn't been maintained in a long time," Kent Walker, Secretary and Landscaping Committee Chair said. "This is being done at no cost to the CID by our firms who do our cleanups along the corridor."

The cemetery is located next to the McDonalds warehouse at Fulton Industrial and Great Southwest Parkway. Within that area, there is a sculpture that was erected in 1967 that the CID is going to restore.

"We want to clean this up. We had to do some homework to see who actually owns this and South Fulton Beautiful is the owner," he said. "We working with them so we can spend our funds to get this sculpture cleaned up and restored back to its original glory."

Gil Prado, Executive Director for the CID stated that a budget has been created to cleanup the sculpture and the property has to be brought into the CID area.

"Once it becomes part of the CID, we can start work on in May and by the summer we should have it restored," he said.

Fulton County Economic Development states they have several projects on the drawing board for development along the area. A college is currently planning to setup shop in the area, the former Mosely Motel property is being looked at and a new warehouse is coming.

"There is much activity going on out here. Since last May, we have seen the location of manufacturing distribution companies and several project inquiries," Ed Nelson, Director of Economic Development for Unincorporated Fulton County said. "With the Mosley Motel property, we are working with a developer for that property and I can tell you won't be another motel."

Public Safety Manager Frank Mazzilli reports that he is working with the Fulton County Police Department.

"We are reversing the trends that we have here. We are working with code enforcement, economic development; and health and wellness departments," he said. "We have many unsavory characters in front many properties out here. We are looking at properties with high call volumes and working on having their licenses revoked. Businesses need to ensure that they are not encouraging or permitting criminal behavior on their properties."
