SUBJECT: FULTON INDUSTRIAL COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT CAUCUS OF ELECTORS

On October 6, 2010, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners approved a resolution consenting to the creation of the Fulton Industrial Community Improvement District ("CID") after obtaining written consents of a majority of the real property owners and seventy-five (75%) percent of the value of all real property within the District, which would be subject to the CID tax. The Community Improvement District is a special tax district in which the property owners tax themselves for the provision of improvement of governmental services and facilities. The CID includes your realty.

At such time within each six-year period following the creation of the CID as the Board of the CID determines appropriate, the question must be put to the Electors present whether to dissolve the CID.

On July 29, 2021, a Caucus of Electors will be held at 3993 Aviation Circle, Atlanta, Georgia 30336, to vote on the question, "Shall the Fulton Industrial Community Improvement District be dissolved?" Registration will be held from 8:30 o'clock a.m. until 9:00 o'clock a.m. with voting occurring immediately thereafter. No one arriving at the registration table after 9:00 o'clock a.m. shall be permitted to vote.

All Electors as designated under the Fulton County Community Improvement Districts Act are invited to attend and cast their votes.
